Re: AQMS 2016 Transition Decision

Conclusion/Recommendation:

ANAB has reviewed the file for CMA's AS 9100:2016 transition and concludes that CMA's ANAB accreditation now includes the AS 9100:2016, AS9110:2016 and AS9120:2016 certification programs.

Recommendation for Annual Assessments:

In accordance with Accreditation Rule 20 & 29, ANAB will confirm full implementation of the revised system at the next normally scheduled office assessment and at an AS 9100:2016 or AS9120:2016 and AS9110 witnessed audit during the transition period. See additional comments on this below under assessment activity.

All other assessments will be in accordance with ANAB's Accreditation Manual, Accreditation Rule 20 and Accreditation Rule 29.

CMA's ANAB accreditation currently includes AS9100, AS9110 and AS9120. As of the date of this letter the OASIS database will reflect the transition only for all three standards AS9100:2016, AS9110:2016 and AS9120:2016. The ANAB accreditation certificate will not be modified.

Now that the AQMS:2016 standards are published CMA is now accredited to issue ANAB-accredited certificates for AS9100:2016 (Rev. D), AS9110:2016 (Rev. C) and AS9120:2016 (Rev. B) following the transition requirements within ANAB Accreditation Rule 29 and the IAQG OPMT Supplemental Rule 003.

History (if Applicable):

The AQMS:2016 application was submitted to ANAB on 14 January 2017 and was reviewed and accepted by Russ Probyn, on 11 February 2017 for AS9100 in full and for AS9110 on 8 April 2017 and for AS9120 on 17 April 2017.

Office Assessment and Witnessed Audit Activity:

Neither an office assessment nor a witnessed audit was required for (prior to) transition, per IAQG OPMT SR003 and ANAB AR29.

Per ANAB Accreditation Manual, MA 5000, Section 10.5, ANAB Staff is authorized by the Accreditation Council to make decisions on transitions to new versions of standards following the process specified for the transition to a given standard.
